


BB DCTech Instructions for PressFit (English)



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR DCTECH - PRESSFIT

BEFORE INSTALLING

Use the tools recommended in this manual

Do not alter the product in any way that may cause risk to the rider or others. Any modification to the product will void the warranty.

DURING USE

Check that there is no lateral movement in the crankset and that they rotate smoothly, Make sure that the cranks are correctly adjusted and tightened to the torque specified by the manufacturer.

> Never clean the bottom bracket with pressurised water or brake cleaner. It is recommended to use a soft brush or a damp cloth and soap.


INSTALLATION

INSTALLATION TOOLS Grease Press


PRESS: Use specific press for bottom bracket. IMPORTANT: pressure must be applied on the outer face of the BB. NEVER ON THE BEARING

Grease Recommendations: FinishLine Premium Grease / Park Tool PPL-1 Polylube 1000 / Mobile 1 Synthetic Grease / Muc-Off Bio Grease / Others

Note: Do not use carbon paste and brake cleaner under any circumstances.





Apply grease to the contact surfaces indicated. Note: Before mounting, check that there are no components inside the frame that could interfere with the BB.



IMPORTANT:

EXCESSIVE compression may affect the integrity of the frame.





Grease and install the connecting rods following the manufacturer's assembly steps.

BEFORE EXTRACTING


Hammer: Use a rubber hammer for removal.


Bottom Bracket Puller: Use a commercially available compatible puller. (Note: depending on the BB model the puller may change):


Examples: Park Tool BBT-90.3 / BBB Cycling BTL / Super B TB-1927A / BBB CUPOUT BB30


Before using the puller: Make sure that the puller fits perfectly aligned on the puller face and not on the bearing. Improper removal can permanently damage the bottom bracket.
